The responses are summarised graphically below. A textual summary of the responses can be found on the school website.



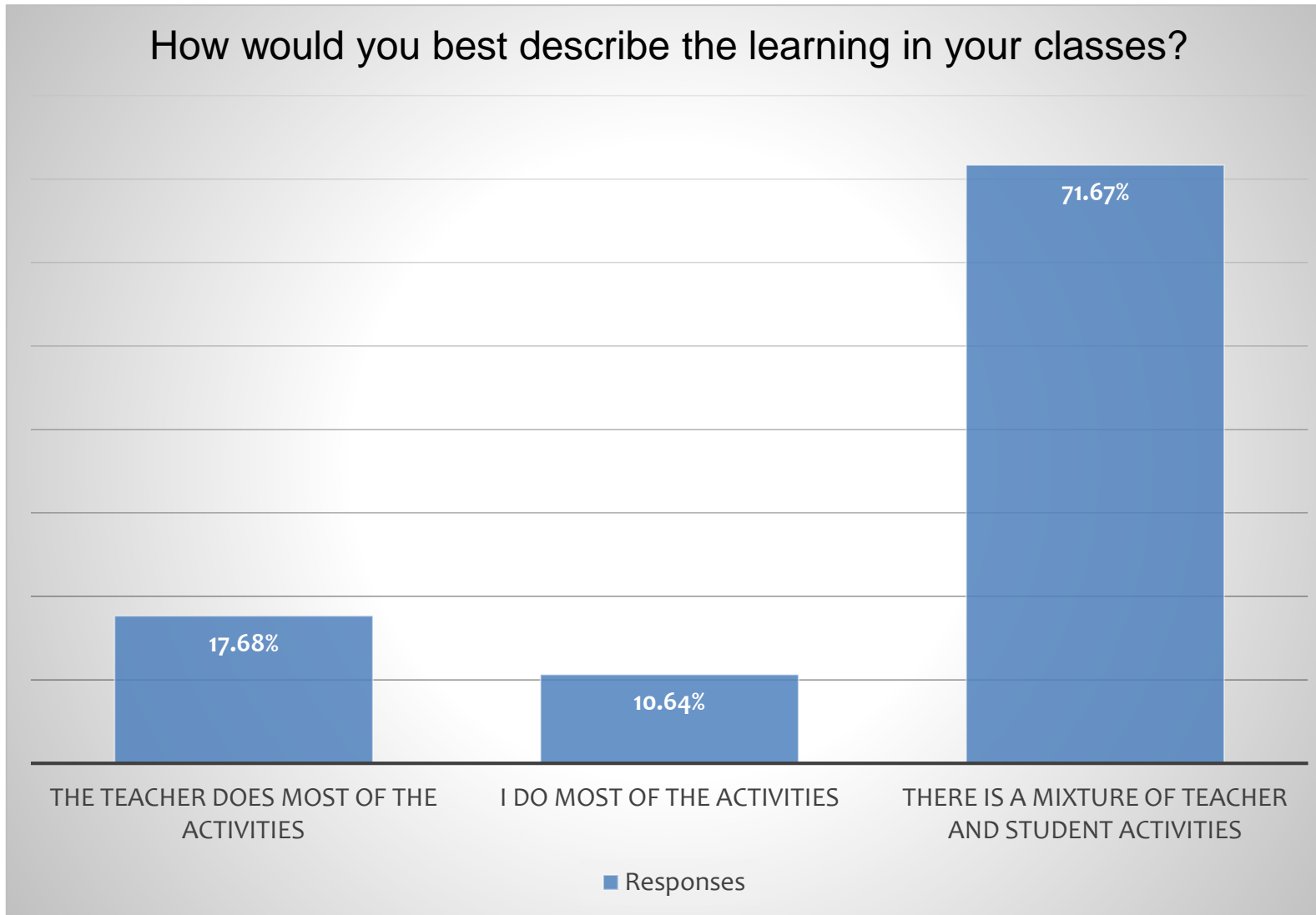

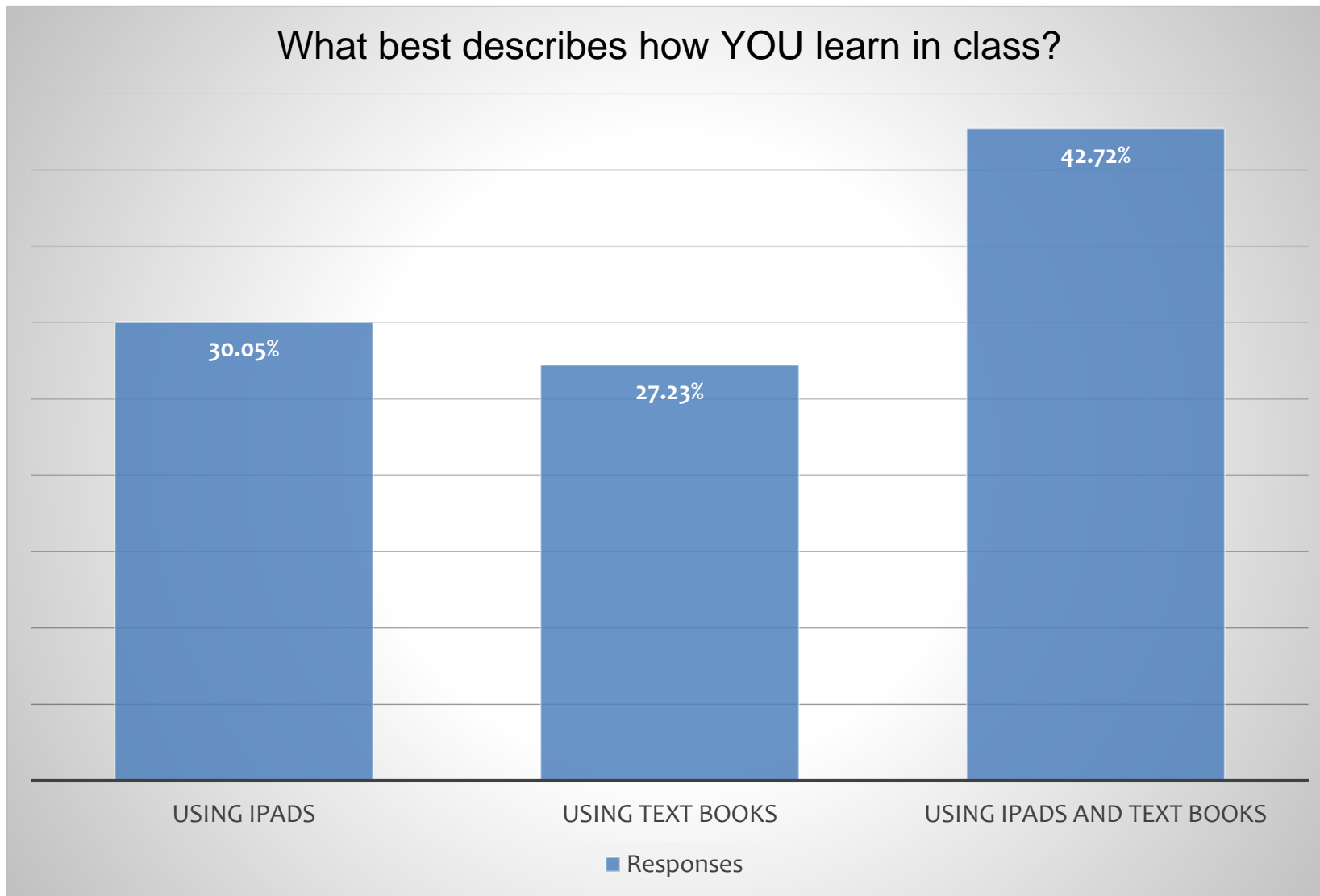

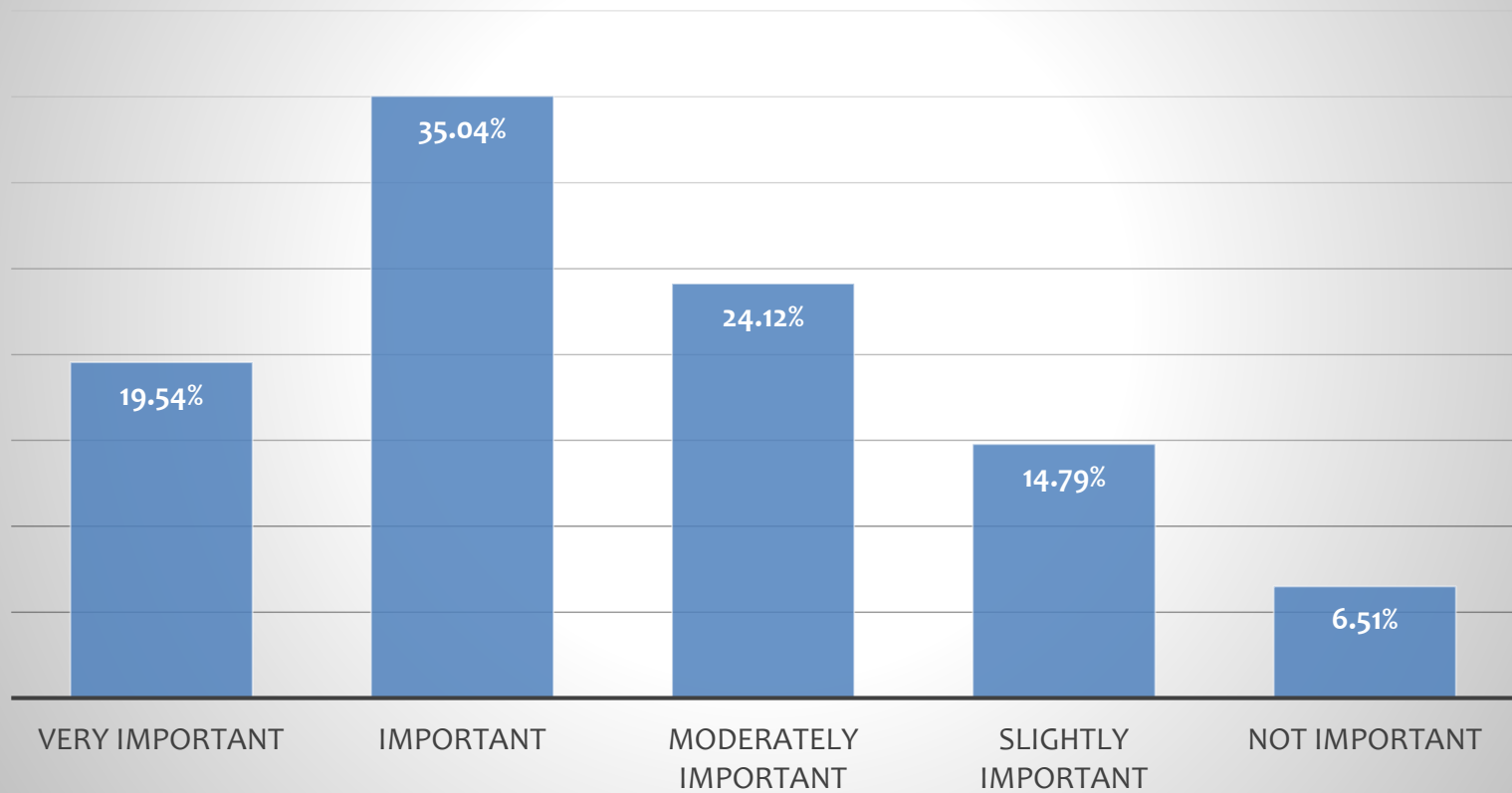
How would you best describe the learning in your classes?



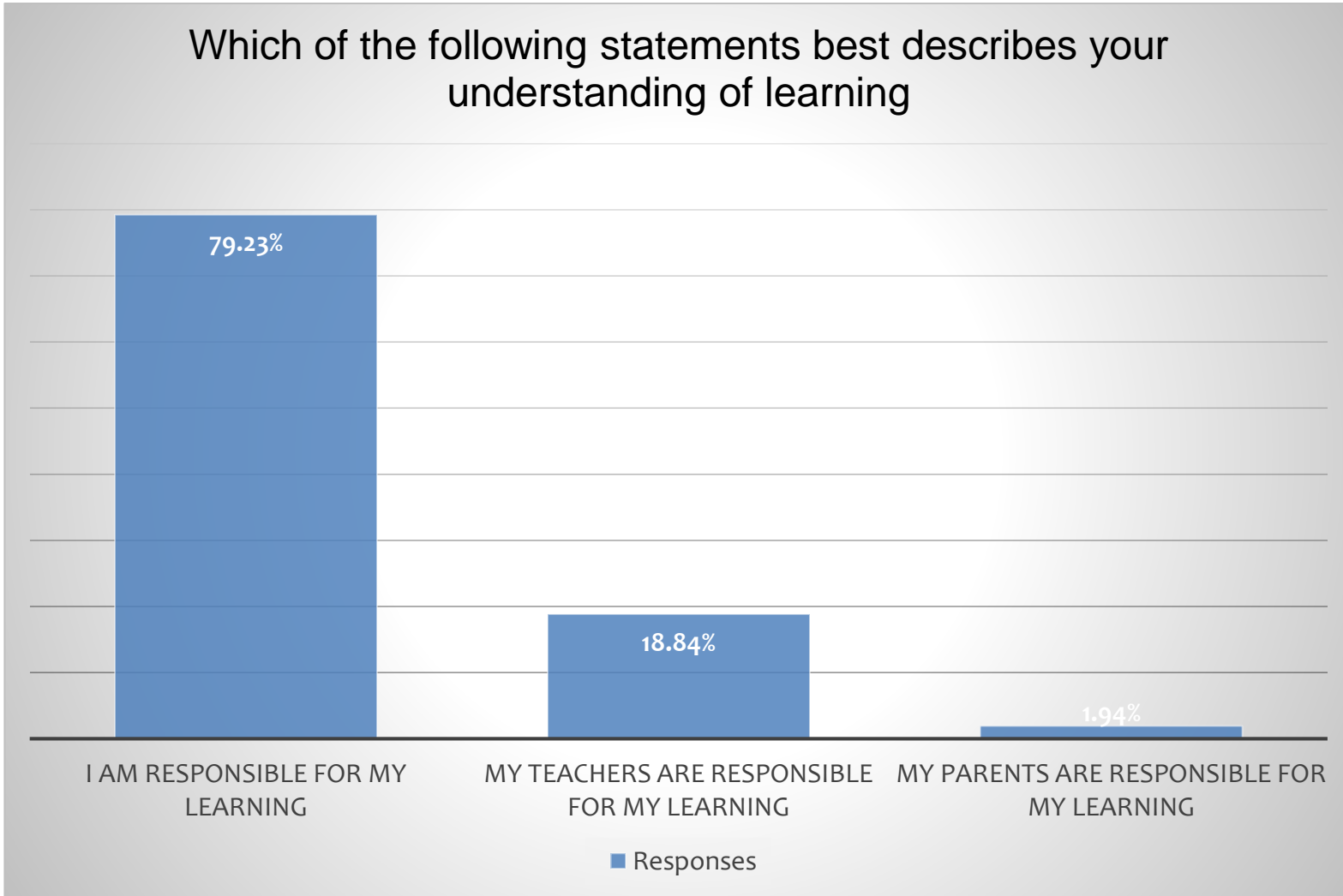
What best describes how YOU learn in class?



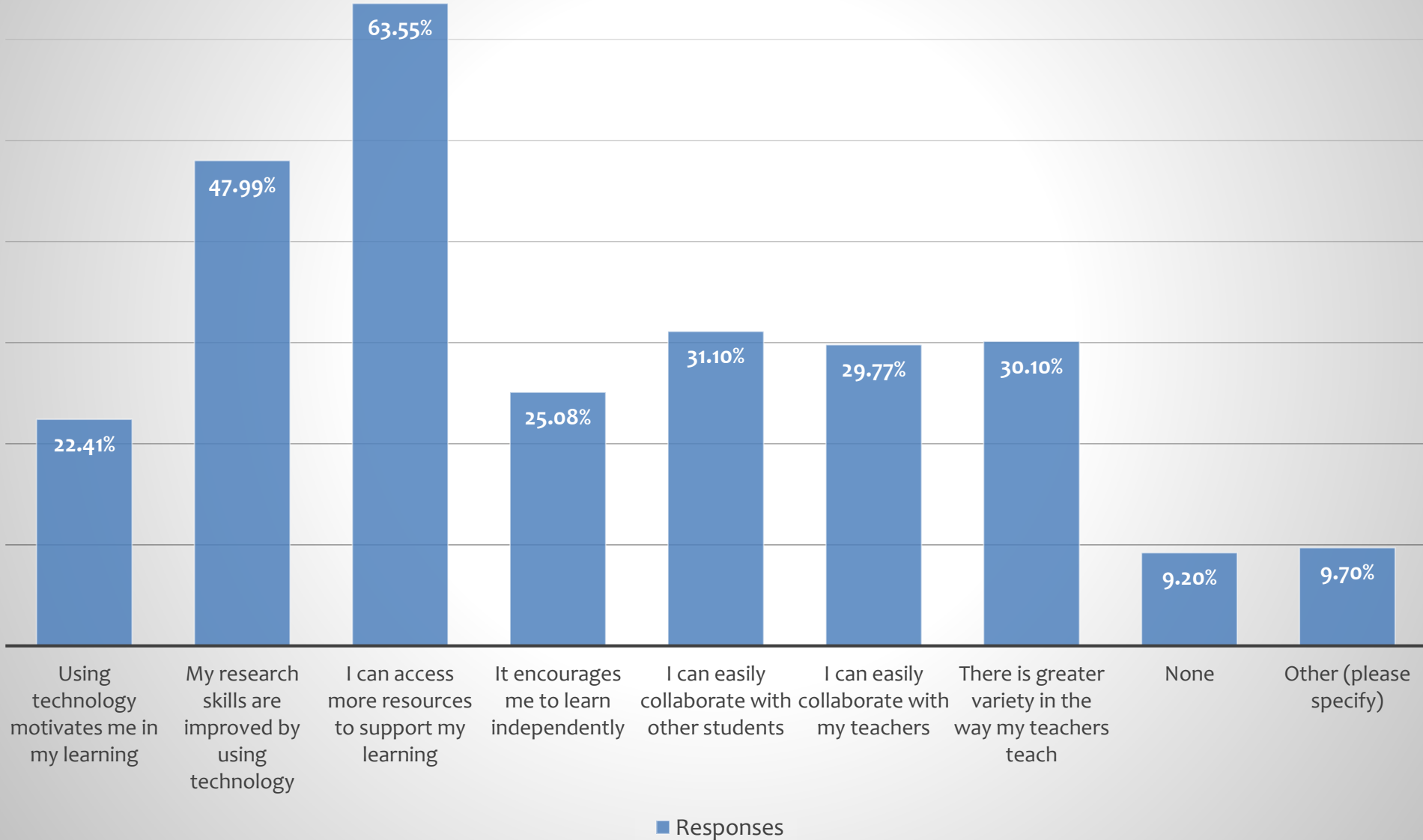
How important is the use of technology in the classroom?



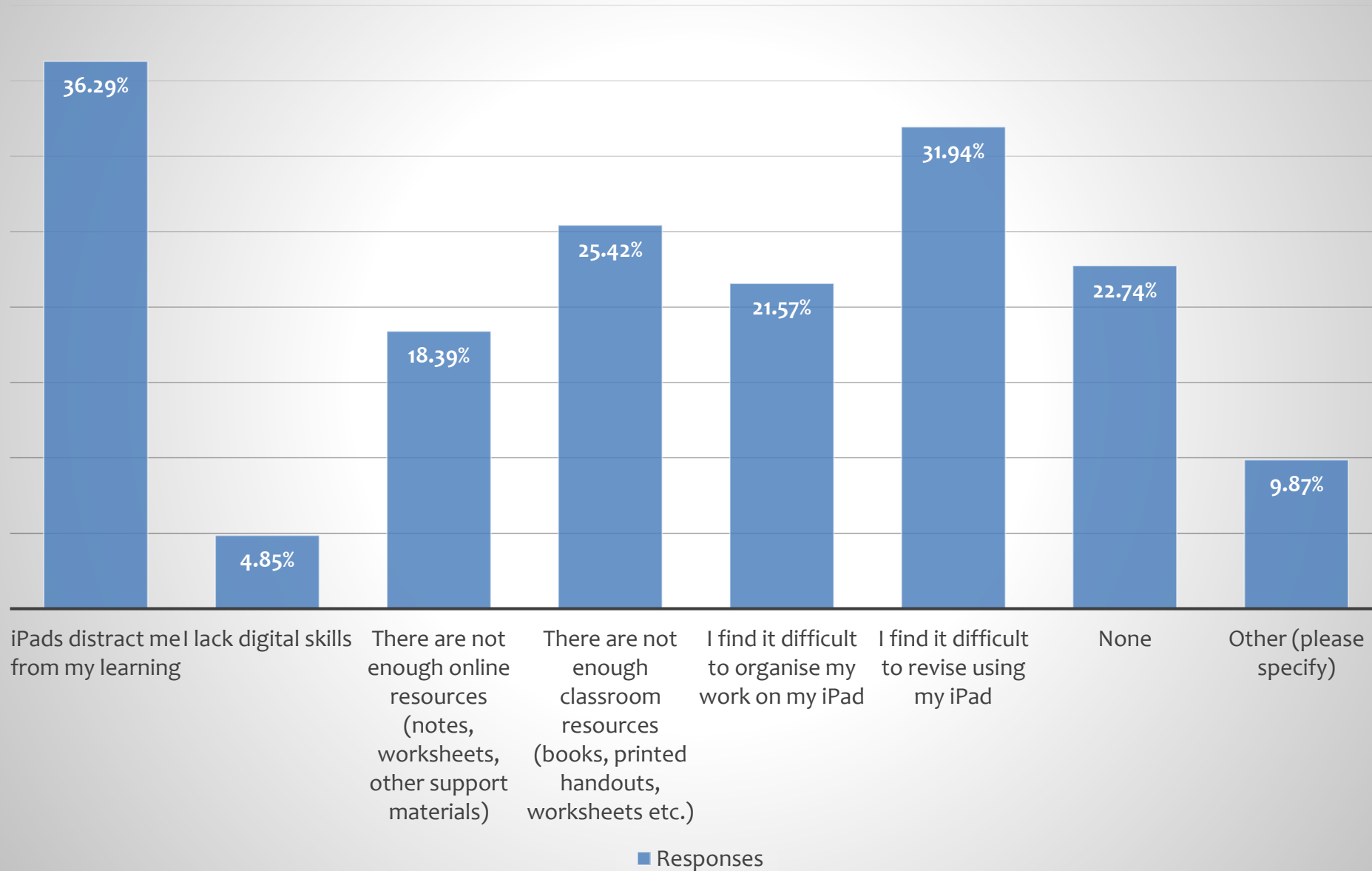
Which of the following statements best describes your understanding of learning



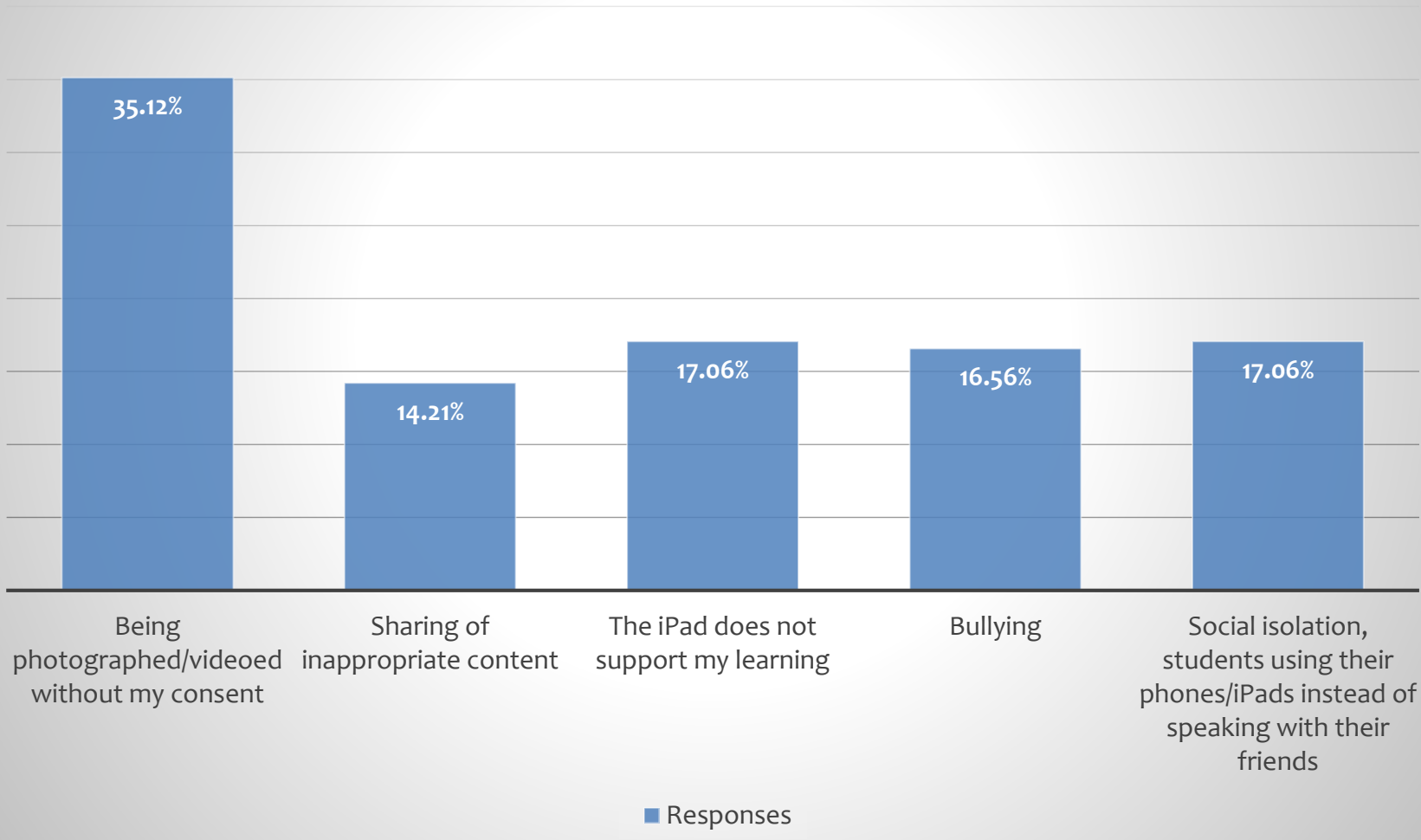
What advantages do you feel exist in relation to iPads being used to support learning and teaching in school?



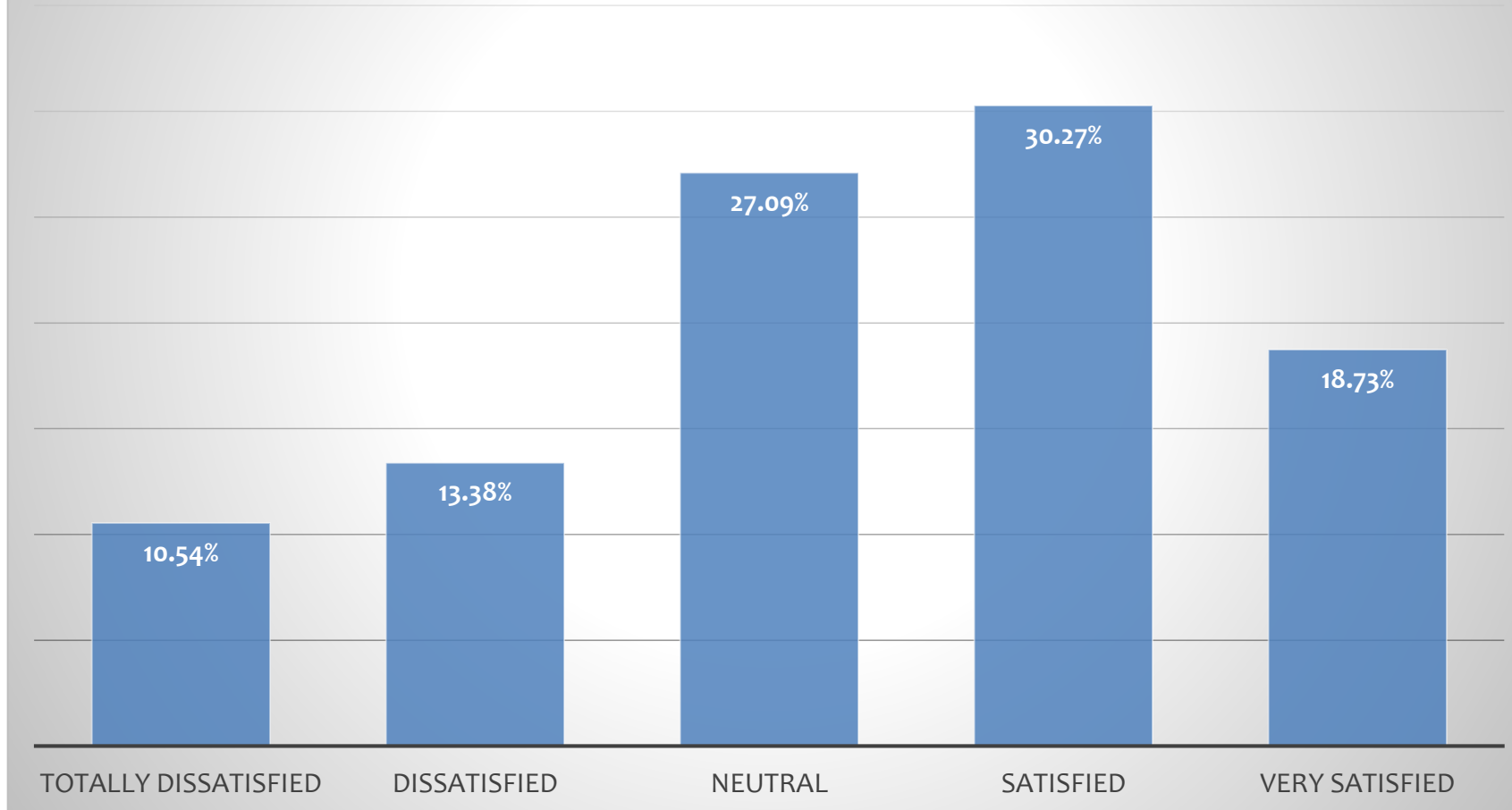
What disadvantages or barriers do you feel exist in relation to iPads being used to support learning and teaching in school?

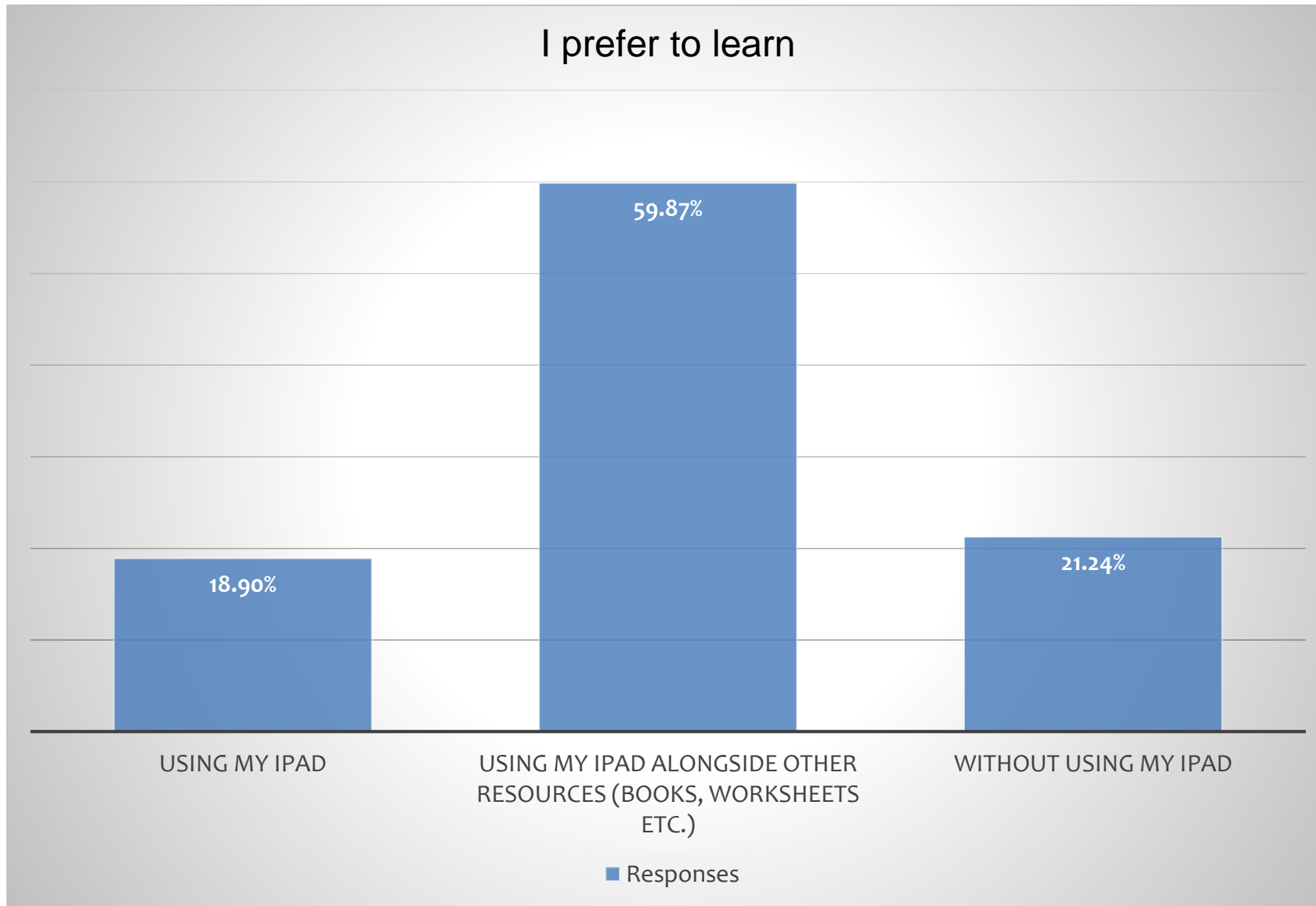

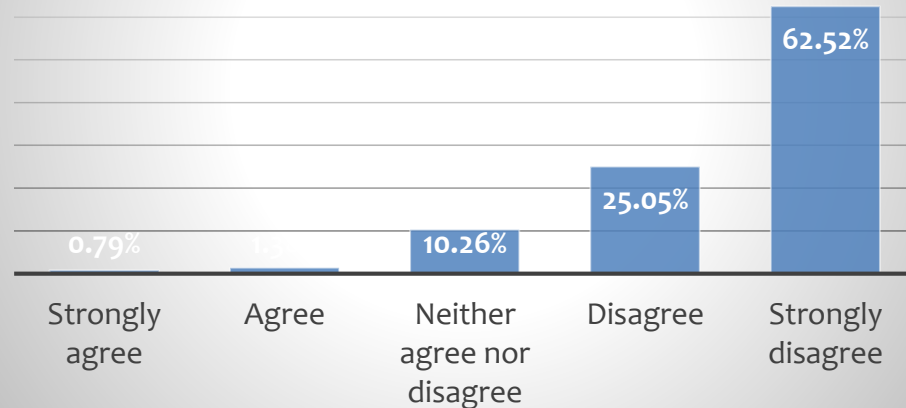
Mobile phone access should only be allowed in class, under the direction and supervision of a teacher (as per current school policy)

Students should have no access to mobile phone allowed in school at any time



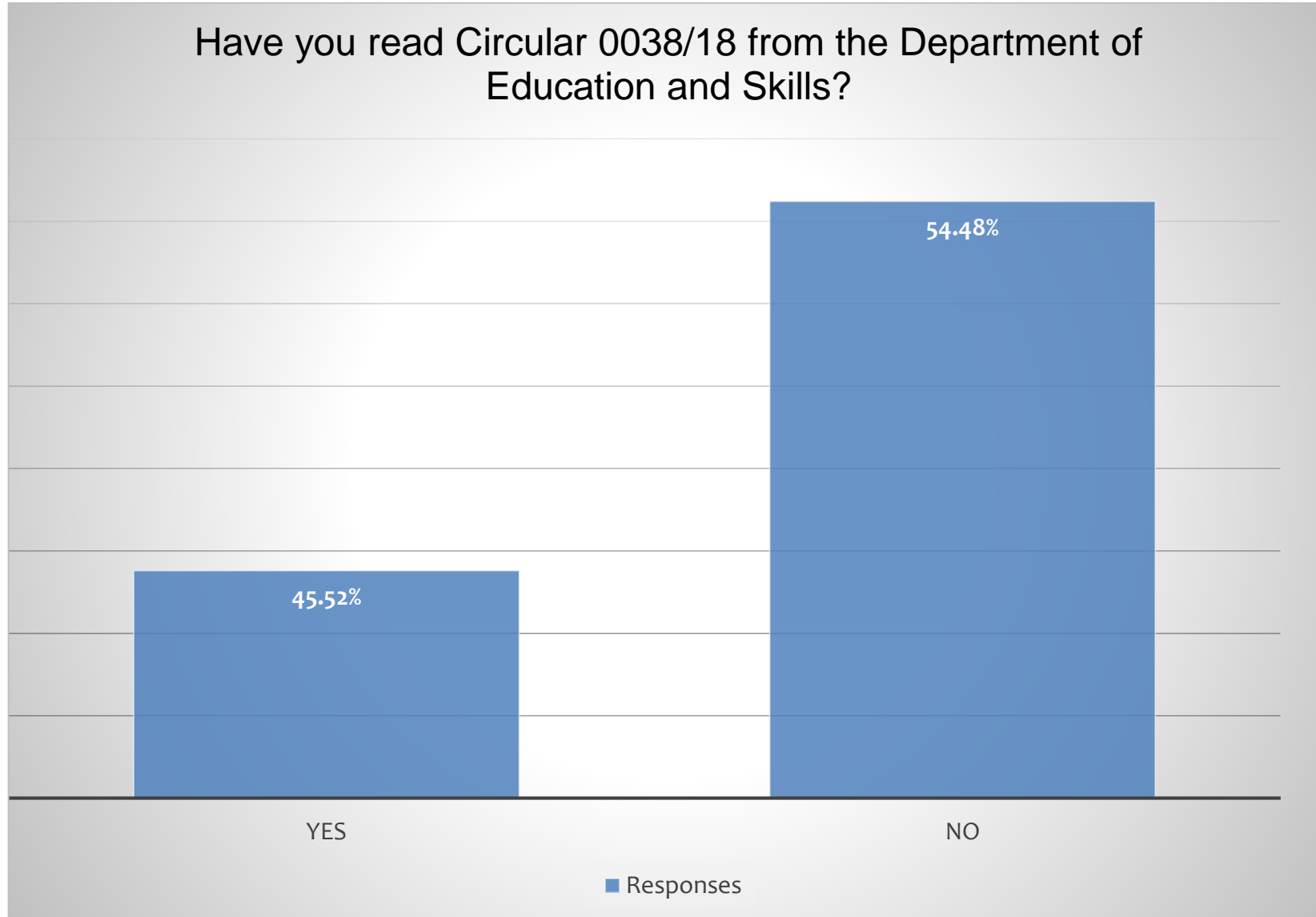

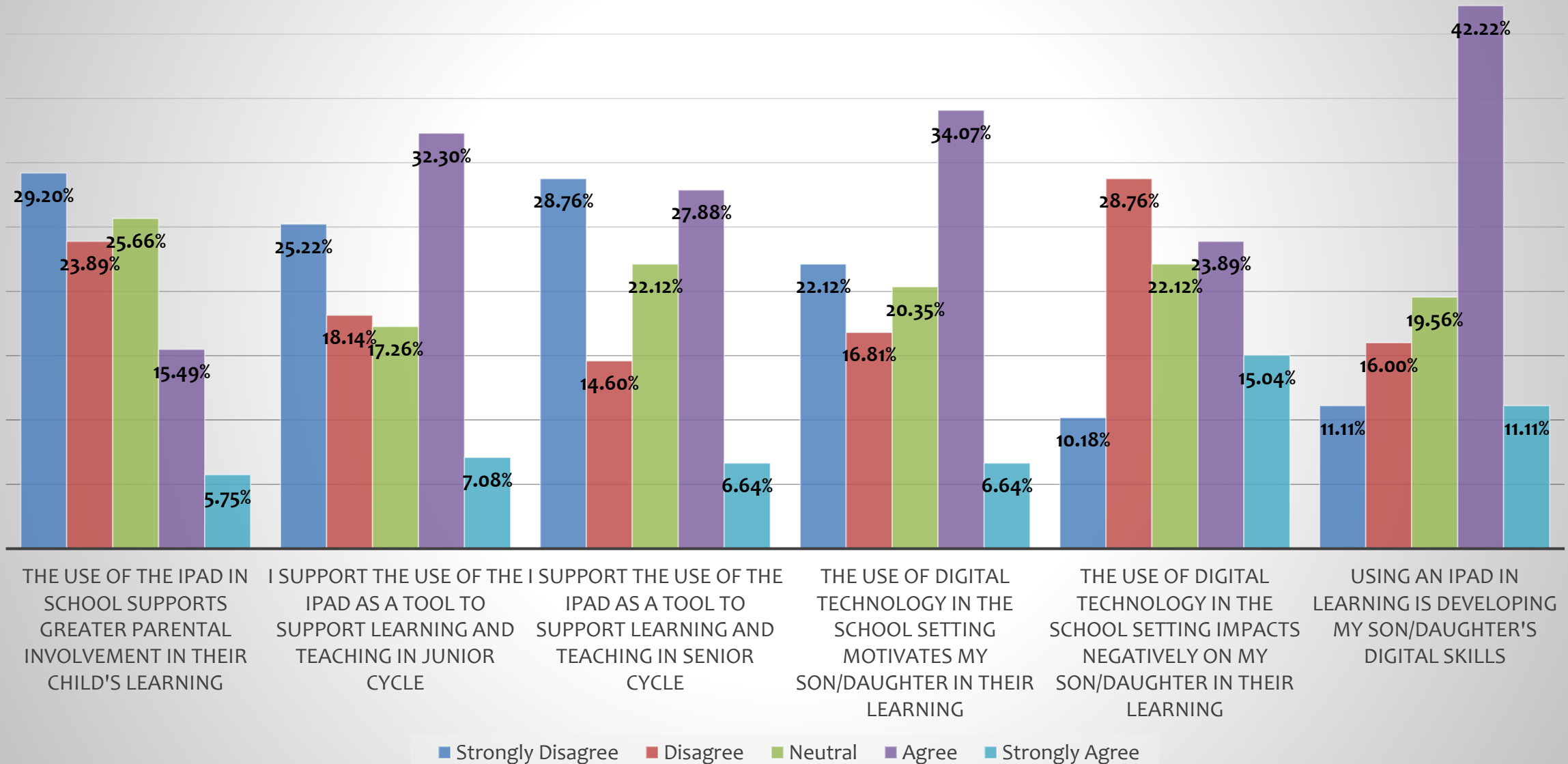

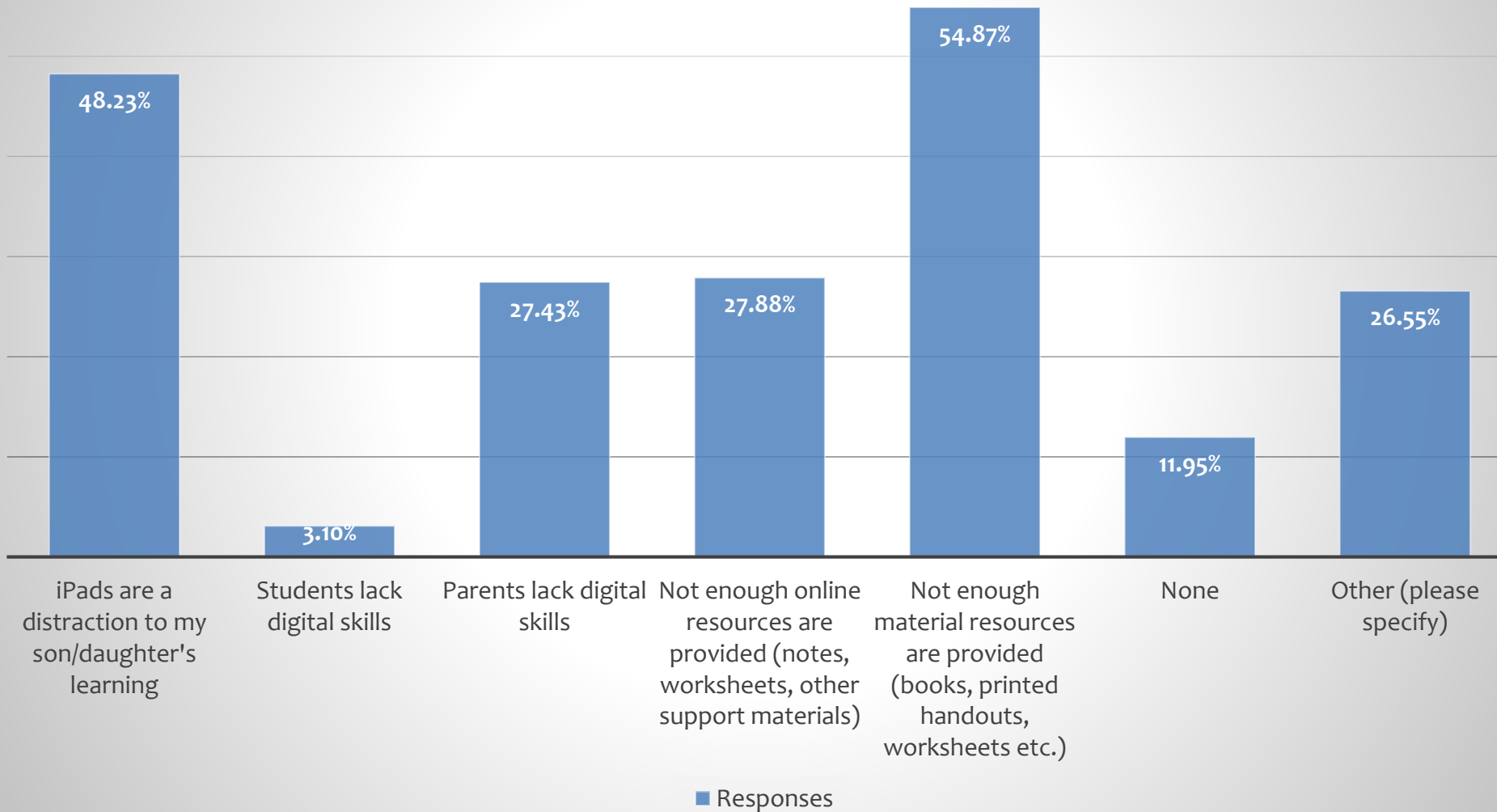

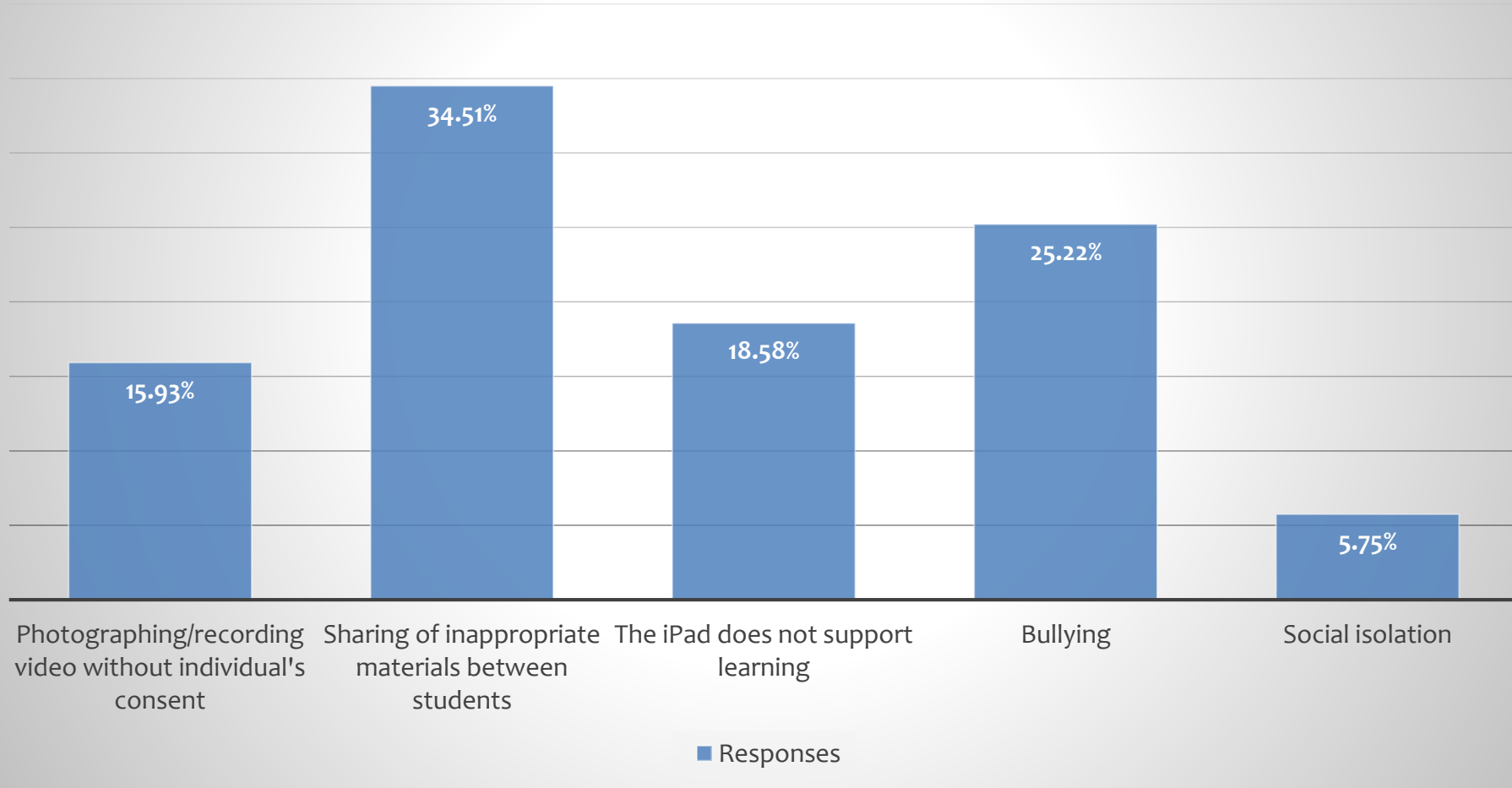

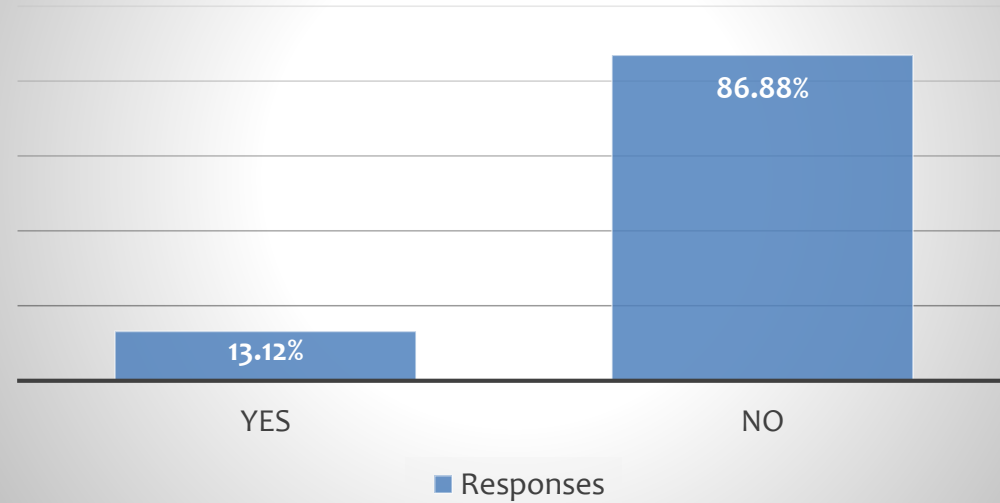

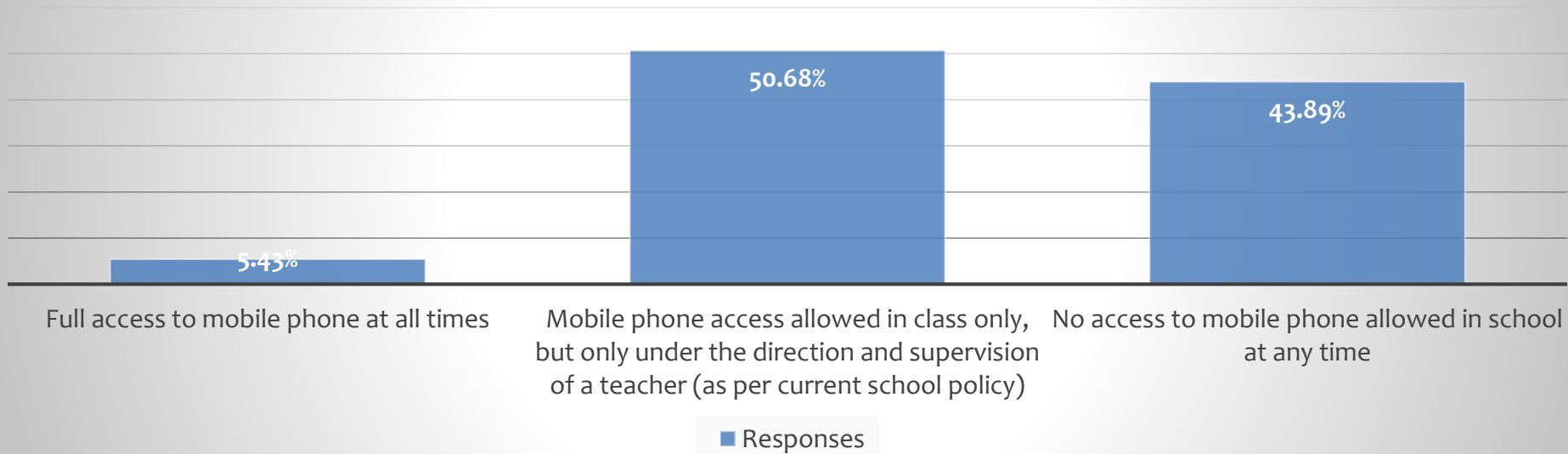

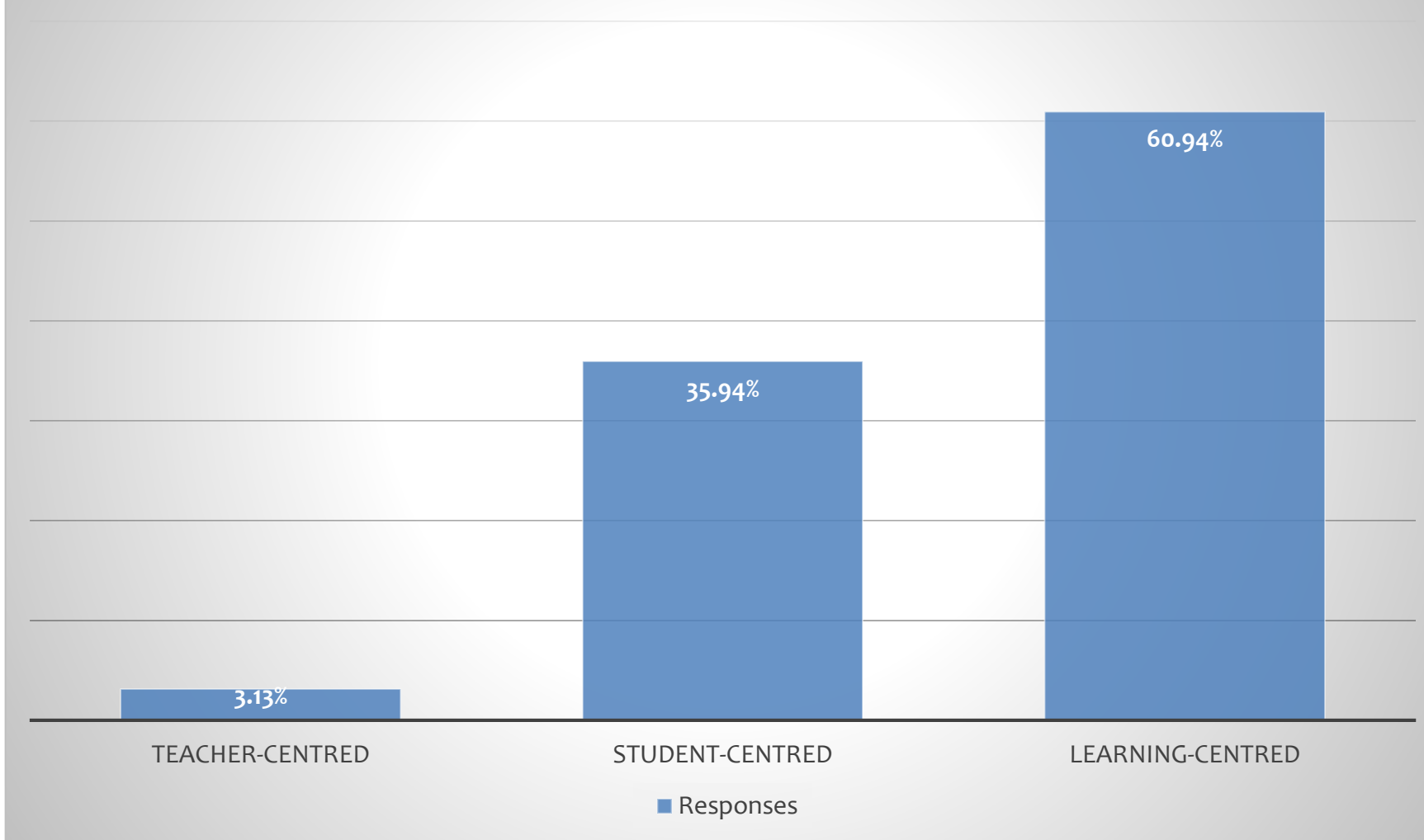

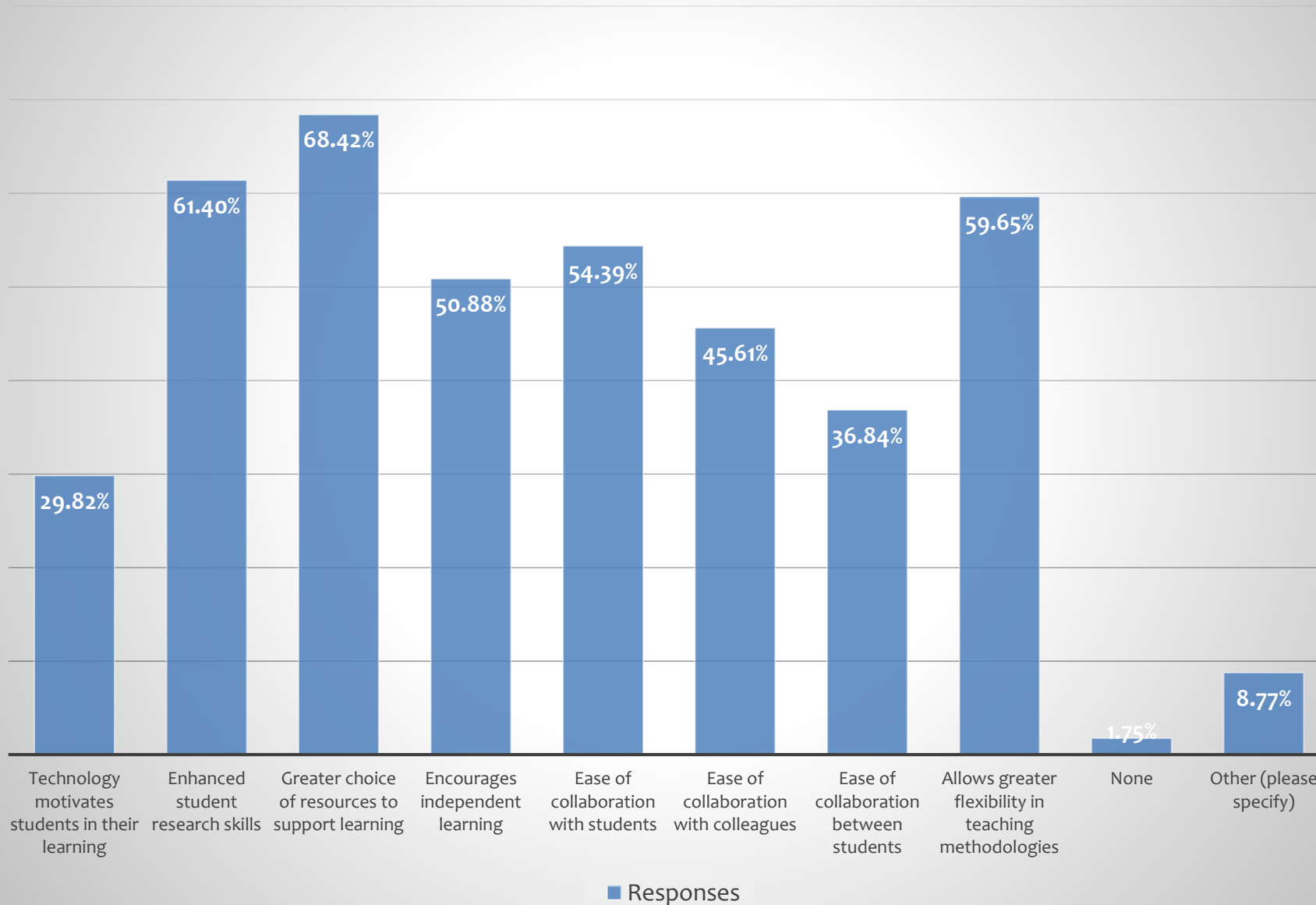
How would you best describe your current teaching methodologies?



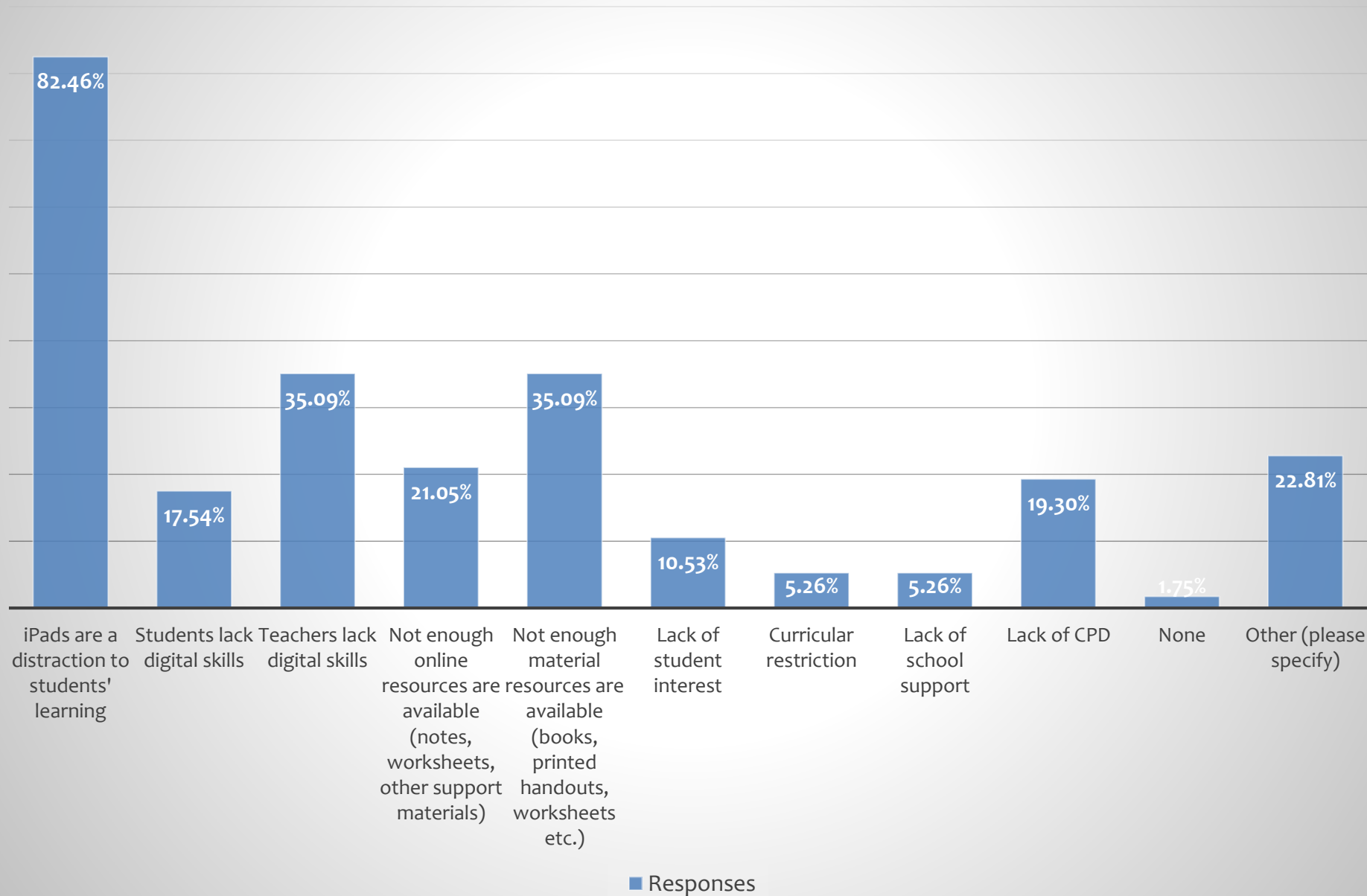

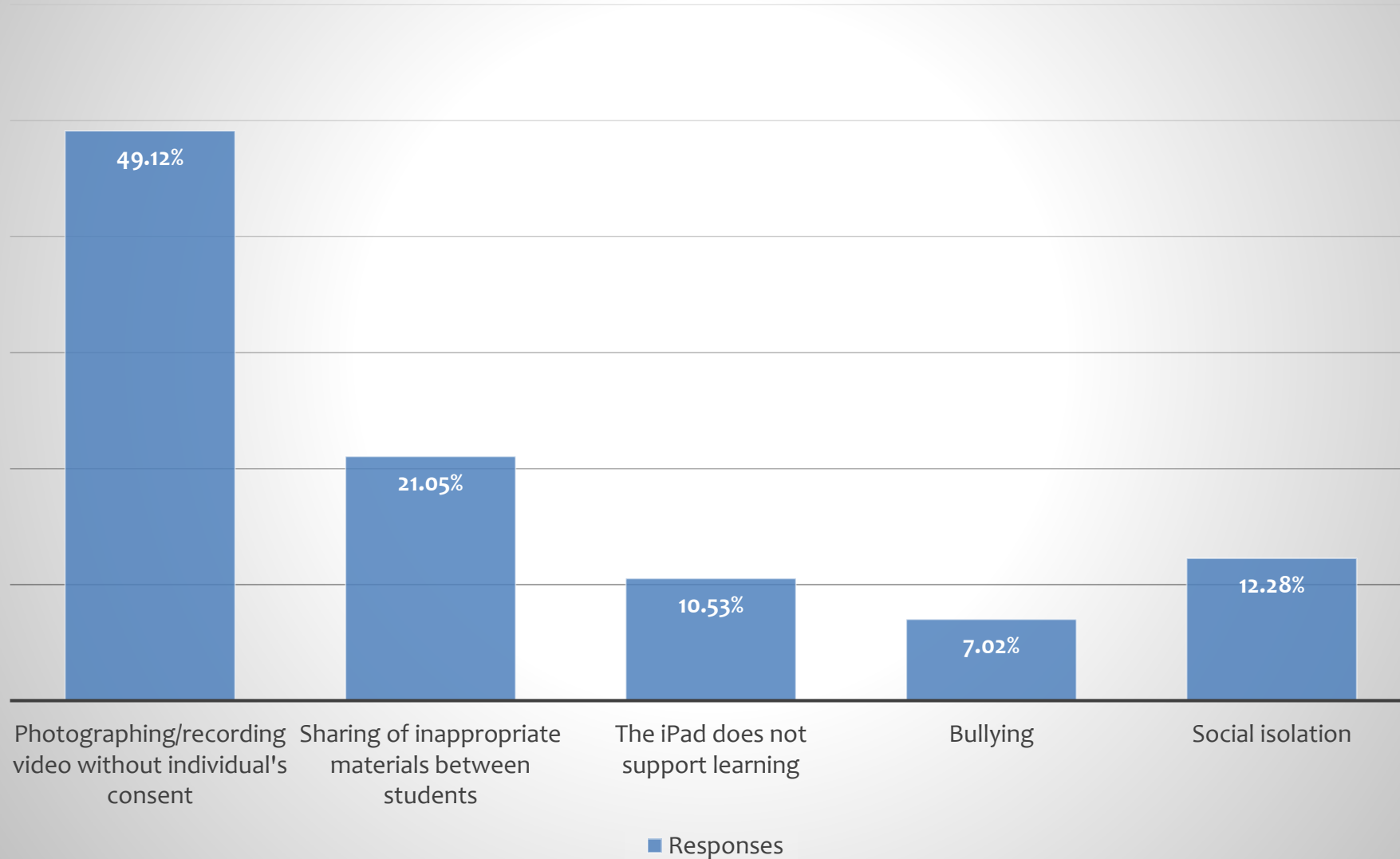

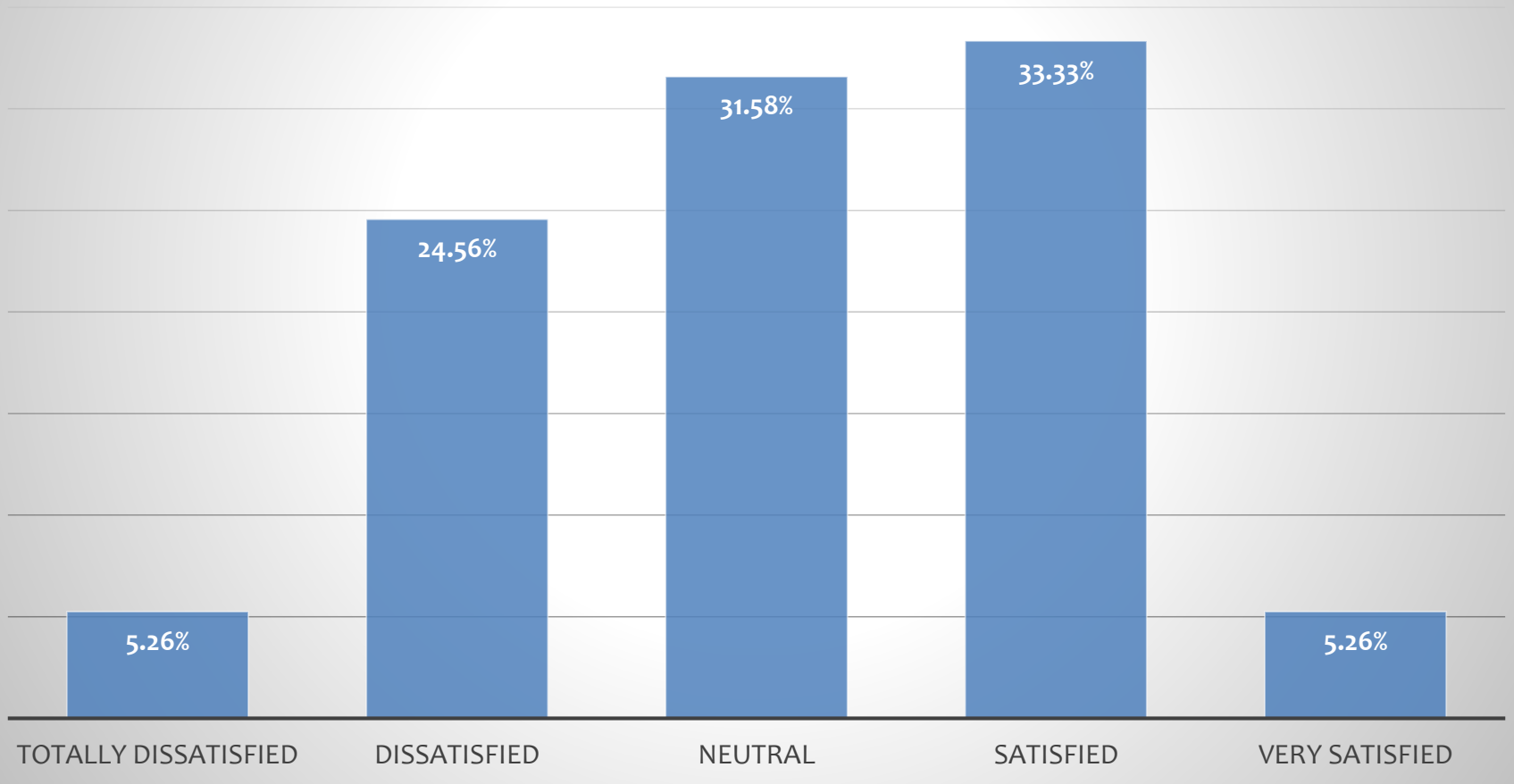
